



2022 Good Faith Estimate / No Surprises Act

Per federal law, Private pay or Out-of-Network clients are offered a Good Faith Estimate that shows the costs of items and services that are reasonably expected for your health care needs for service. The estimate is based on information known at the time the estimate was created.

The Good Faith Estimate does not include Potential Add-On Services or Business Charges That are Unknown, Unexpected, or Unpredicted at the time of scheduling that may arise during treatment. You could be charged more if complications or special circumstances occur. The estimated costs are valid through the end of the calendar year for the year the Good Faith Estimate was provided.
